Winemaker Note

A very late season freeze in mid-May affected 30% of this varietal's primary shoots and bud breaks. Thankfully, a secondary bud break was quite abundant causing a good portion of fruit on the secondaries to be dropped to help vine balance and create a better wine. A long, cool growing season with lower-than-average yields along with gentle winemaking produced a wine that is more feminine in nature with tons of structure, balance, and complexity.

Nose

Honeycomb and peach.

Palate

Over-delivers in taste and texture. With a high amount of refreshing acidity and subtle tartness, you'll find your mouth puckering by mid-palate. Flavors of sweet melon, lemon peel, honeysuckle, and a touch of salinity make this a classic expression of Albariño. Enjoy an inherent coolness on the finish with subtle hints of citrus pith and lime.

Enjoy With, When, and How

Light, zesty, and full of fun, this wine is meant for the sun and should be drunk while young. The perfect aperitif, pour a few glasses and serve alongside a robust charcuterie board. Choose from soft cheeses like burrata and feta to semi-hard cheeses such as manchego and English cheddar.
